Portfolio

Many Wayside texts have an integrated Portfolio, linked to Can-Do statements, that allows students to self-assess their progress and demonstrate understanding. 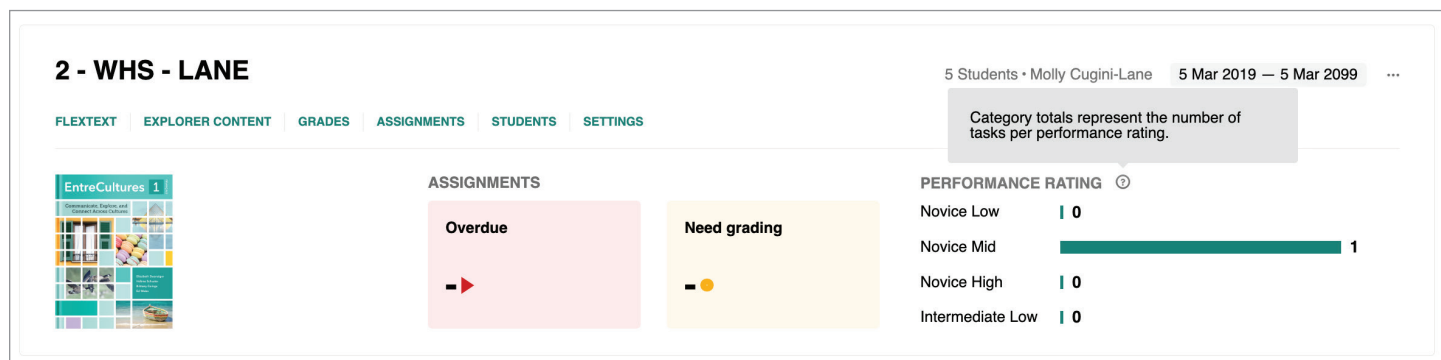
