The Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®], our Learning Management System, is the central hub for teachers and students that bridges content, pedagogy, technology, and training to create a comprehensive digital environment that ensures students and teachers are on the path to proficiency and engaging with equitable and innovative pedagogical resources.

Wayside Publishing[®] is proud to offer an IMS Global certified Thin Common Cartridge (TCC) integration with Canvas by Instructure. With this integration, users access and engage with the Learning Site[®] digital content within a Canvas instructional course.

When you are ready to get started with the integration, the Wayside Publishing[®] Integrations Team will provide you with a Consumer Key, Shared Secret, and IMSCC file(s) that will allow you to import Learning Site[®] content and resources via a TCC directly into a Canvas course. Learning Site[®] users will need to be provisioned with Learning Site[®] accounts before they can use the Wayside Publishing[®] Canvas TCC integration.

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NOTE: The Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®] TCC Integration is only available to rostered customers. For more information on our rostering options, please visit waysidepublishing.com/ digital-solutions/rostering.



Installation Options

The Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®] Canvas TCC integration allows multiple installation options to best fit your district's needs. Since the imported Learning Site[®] content contained in the IMSCC file can be copied to multiple instructional courses that use the same textbook title or reused, the IMSCC file can be added as a shared resource in a shared non-instructional Canvas course or as an individual resource in an individual Canvas course. Please read below to learn more about each installation option.


NOTE: The IMSCC file cannot be added to the Canvas Commons.

Shared Resource in a Shared Non-Instructional Course

If multiple teachers will be using the same textbook title, the IMSCC file can be added to a Canvas non-instructional course (i.e. a "sandbox" course) from which teachers can copy modules and content into their individual Canvas instructional courses. If this is your preferred installation option, please note that an external tool provider will need to be configured with your district's Consumer Key and Shared Secret in each individual course that will be using the Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®] Canvas TCC integration, including any "sandbox" course(s).

Individual Resource in an Individual Course

If one teacher will be using a textbook title, the IMSCC file can be added to that teacher's individual Canvas instructional course(s) or to a non-instructional course (i.e. a "sandbox" course). If added to a non-instructional course, a teacher can copy modules and content into other Canvas instructional courses that will be using the same textbook title.






Installation Directions: Importing the IMSCC File(s)

The Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®] Canvas TCC integration requires you to import the IMSCC file for each text title and configure the external tool for each instructional course by adding your district's Consumer Key and Shared Secret provided by Wayside Publishing[®]. Please follow the directions below to import the IMSCC file(s) containing Learning Site[®] content into Canvas.


1. Contact the Wayside Publishing[®] Integrations Team at rostering@waysidepublishing.com to receive each textbook title's IMSCC file and your district's Consumer Key and Shared Secret.



- 2. In your Canvas account, select the course you would like to integrate with the Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®].
- 3. Navigate to the course Settings page.
- 4. Select Import Course Content from the right-hand menu in the course Settings page.


5. In the Import Content window, select to import a **Common Cartridge**, add the IMSCC file provided by Wayside Publishing[®] as the source, and choose to import **All content**.



6. When ready, select Import. You will see the status of the import under "Current Jobs".

7. Once the job finishes and the import is complete, you will see a notification indicating one reported issue. The issue reported is related to security settings and the Wayside Publishing[®] external app configuration. To resolve the issue, navigate to the course Settings page by selecting **Settings** in the left-hand menu. Then, follow the directions in the Installation Directions: Configuring the External Tool Provider section of this guide to complete the installation process.





Installation Directions: Configuring the External Tool Provider

As a final step, you will need to configure a new external tool provider using your district's Consumer Key and Shared Secret provided by Wayside Publishing[®]. The external tool must be added to each course that will be using the Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®] Canvas TCC integration.

NOTE: The external tool can be added to individual courses by individual teachers or added at the system level by a Canvas administrator.

- 1. On the course Settings page, navigate to the Apps tab and select **View App Configurations** to access your list of external apps. Select the **gear icon** next to Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®] and select **Edit**.
- 2. In the Edit App menu, copy and paste the Consumer Key and Shared Secret for your district, and make sure the Privacy setting is **Public**.

With this integration, users access and engage with the Learning Site[®] digital content within a Canvas instructional course.

TIP: Imported module content links can be moved to another module, copied, renamed, and reused.

Module Access

It is important that teachers and students have access to the following imported modules from each IMSCC file in each of your Canvas instructional courses:

- **FlexText**[®] This module provides access to the digital version of your Wayside text. Teachers have access to the student edition and teacher edition. Students have access to the student edition only.
- Grades This module provides access to task submissions and scores through the Learning Site® Grades tab. Teachers have access to view and provide feedback on all rostered student task submissions using the Learning Site® grading and feedback tools. Students have access to their task submissions, scores, and feedback. Students can also use this link to add evidence directly to their portfolio.
- Portfolio This module provides access to the integrated portfolio. Teachers have access to all
 rostered student portfolios. Students have access to their individual current portfolio and any
 previous course portfolios they may have (if applicable).


Task Activity Grade Passback

Learning Site[®] task activities are eligible for grade passback, a feature of Canvas that allows numeric scores to be passed from Learning Site[®] into your Canvas gradebook.


Enabling Grade Passback

To create a task activity assignment in Canvas with grade passback enabled, follow the steps below or view the Integration Video Tutorial.

1. Locate the task activity content link you wish to assign and select the 3-dot menu on the right. Next, select **Edit** to open the Edit Item Details menu.



- In the Edit Item Details window, copy the entire activity URL. After copying the URL, select X or Cancel to close the window.
 - **TIP:** Use your keyboard commands to quickly select, copy, and add the entire activity URL to your clipboard.



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3. Next, create a Canvas assignment. Enter an assignment title and any additional information you wish to add. Under Submission Type, choose **External Tool**, and then paste the URL that you copied into the field.

NOTE: It is not necessary to select Find or Load this Tool in a New Tab.

4. Add any required or additional information and then select **Save** or **Save and Publish**.

NOTE: You may enter the point value as it appears on Learning Site[®] or you may adjust the point values to your preference and the grade will scale accordingly in your Canvas gradebook. Task activities on Learning Site[®] are based on a 100-point scale and scores are displayed as a percentage.

The task activity will now be embedded within the Canvas assignment for student access and completion. This assignment may be copied and/or used with other instructional courses using the same textbook title.



Completing a Task Activity with Grade Passback Enabled

Students will complete the task activity through the Canvas assignment enabled for grade passback that you created. For a score to successfully pass from the Learning Site[®] activity to your Canvas gradebook, the activity must be accessed from the Canvas assignment and not from the imported content link or Grades module link.


Reviewing Numeric Scores for Grade Passback

Numeric scores from **auto-graded task activities** will appear in your Canvas gradebook as soon as a student selects the **Submit** button. Numeric scores from **manually graded task activities** appear in your Canvas gradebook as soon as you enter a score using the Learning Site[®] grading and feedback tools accessed from the imported Grades module link.

Setting Grades Viewing Filter for Task Activities

In order to view task activity submissions, both teachers and students must enable the **Not assigned, but attempted by students** grade filter. Please note that filters will be visible after the first task activity is submitted.

To enable the filter, select the **Grades** module link. Select **Filters** and then **Activities**. In the Activities menu, select **Not assigned**, **but attempted by students**.

Task activities will be visible once teachers and students have enabled the filter. The filter will remain enabled unless manually disabled.
