


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Overview

The Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®], our Learning Management System, is the central hub for teachers and students that bridges content, pedagogy, technology, and training to create a comprehensive digital environment that ensures students and teachers are on the path to proficiency and engaging with equitable and innovative pedagogical resources.

The Learning Site[®] integration with Google Classroom is a customizable experience that offers the functionality of both Learning Site[®] and Google Classroom. With this integration, users primarily access and engage with Learning Site[®] digital content through a direct link on a Google Classroom post.


To use this integration, users will need both an active Learning Site[®] account and Google Classroom account. Teachers will be prompted to connect their Google account to their Learning Site[®] account when they first select to share content from Learning Site[®] as a Google Classroom post. No complicated and time-consuming configuration is required.

Connecting a Google Account


Teachers will be prompted to connect their Google account to their Learning Site® account once they first select to share content from Learning Site® to Google Classroom. Students will not be required to connect their Google account to their Learning Site® account.



Sharing Learning Site® Content to Google Classroom

Learning Site® content is shared as a direct link on a Google Classroom post through a simple, streamlined process.

1. Log into Learning Site® and navigate to an Explorer® Class.
2. Locate an activity or resource you would like to share from Learning Site® to Google Classroom. Shareable Learning Site® content can be found in the Explorer® Content tab or from the FlexText® compass icon.
3. Once you have located content you would like to share, select the **Share** button and then select the **Google Classroom** icon.




4. In the Share to Classroom pop-up window, select a **class**, choose an **action**, and then select **Go** to be taken to the Google Classroom post detail window.



TIP: You can share Learning Site® content with additional classes or sections using the same textbook in the Google Classroom post detail window.

5. Use the Google Classroom functionality to create your post. You can edit the prepopulated title, add instructions or additional resources, select to share the post with multiple classes or individual students using the same textbook, add grade details or a due date, select a topic, and use the assigning options.



NOTE: Google Classroom posts with Learning Site® content links can be copied and reused.

Accessing Content: Teachers and Students

The Learning Site[®] content link attached to a Google Classroom post will provide direct access to the Learning Site[®] digital content from Google Classroom. Users who are not logged in to Learning Site[®] will be prompted to log in using their method of access.




Assignment Management Options

The Wayside Publishing® Learning Site® Google Classroom integration provides options for managing assignments based on preference. Assignments created by using the **Share button** on Learning Site® and posted to Google Classroom’s Classwork page can be managed using Google Classroom functionality. These assignments will not appear on the Learning Site® Assignments tab. If desired, teachers can choose to also use Learning Site® functionality to create assignments that will appear on the Learning Site® Assignments tab.



Setting Grades Tab Viewing Filter for Task Activities

In order to view task activity submissions that are not assigned to students using the Learning Site® assigning tools, both teachers and students must enable the **Not assigned, but attempted by students** grade filter. Please note that filters will be visible after the first task activity is submitted.

To enable the filter, navigate to the **Grades** tab on Learning Site®. Select **Filters** and then **Activities**. In the Activities menu, select **Not assigned, but attempted by students**.

Task activities will be visible once teachers and students have enabled the filter. The filter will remain enabled unless manually disabled.
