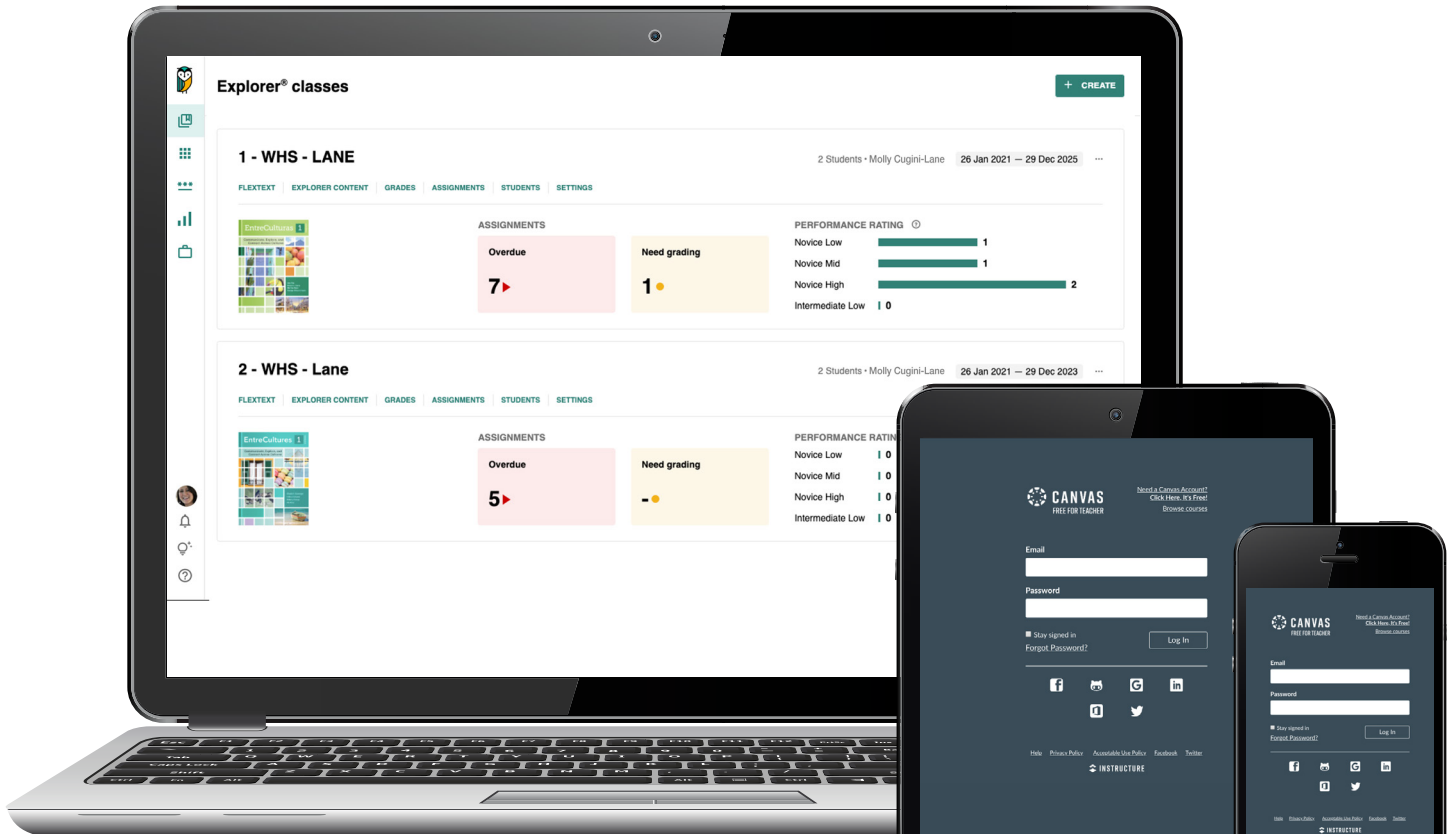

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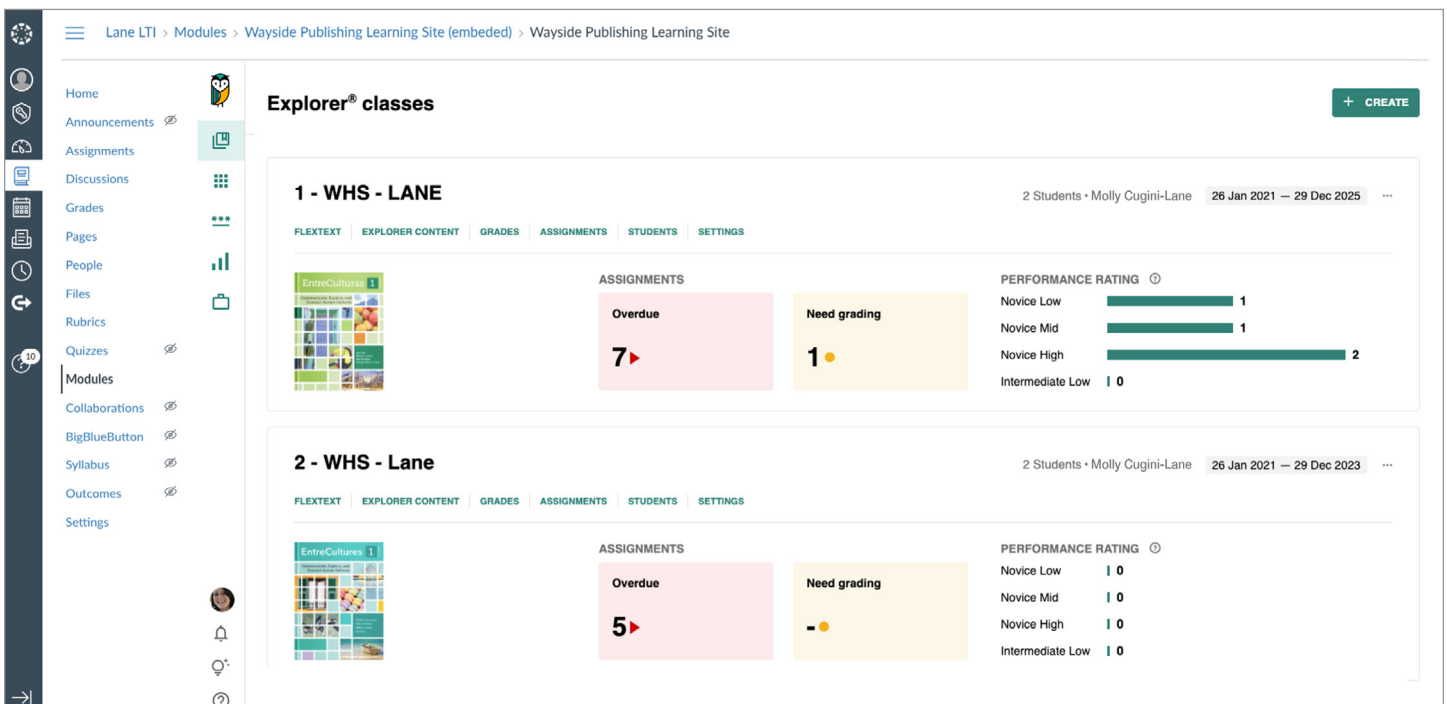
Overview

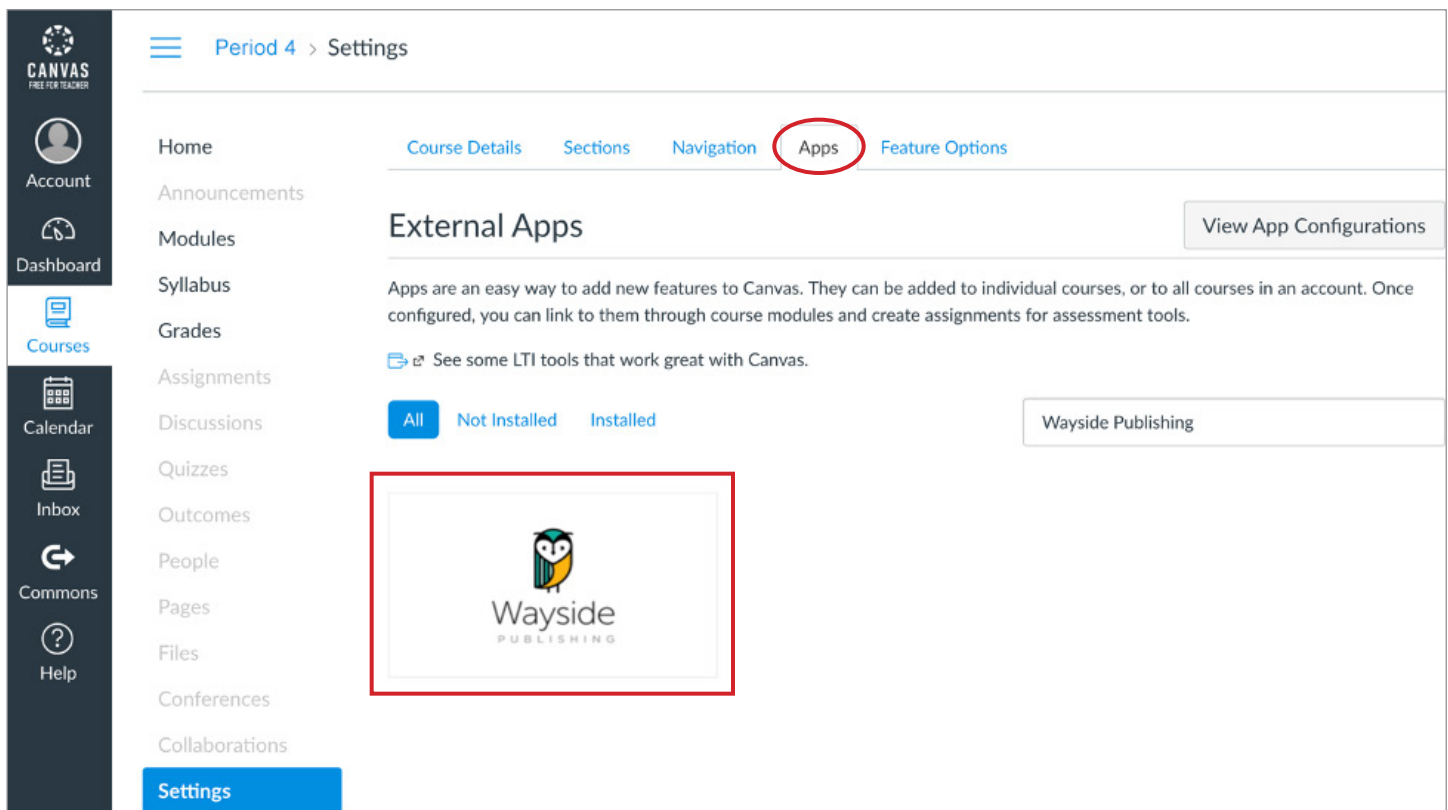

Installing the LTI Edu App: Administrator-Level Instructions

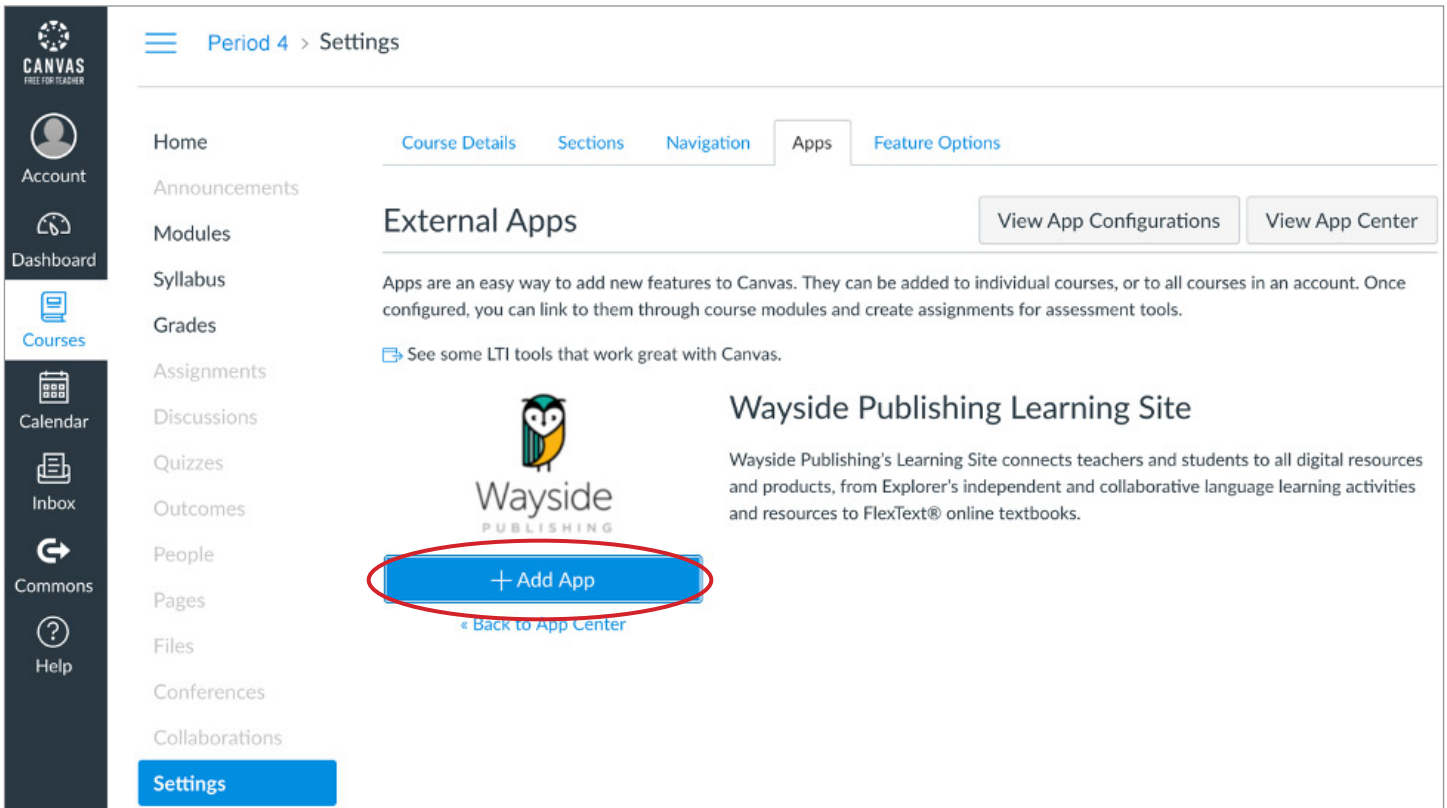
If you are the Canvas administrator for your district and will install the Wayside Publishing® LTI Edu App for use across world language classrooms within your district, please follow the directions below.

1. Contact the Wayside Publishing® Integrations Team at rostering@waysidepublishing.com to receive your district's Consumer Key and Shared Secret.
2. In your Canvas Administrator account, navigate to your district Settings page.
3. Select **Apps**.
4. Type "Wayside Publishing" into the search field and select the **Wayside Publishing® external app**.

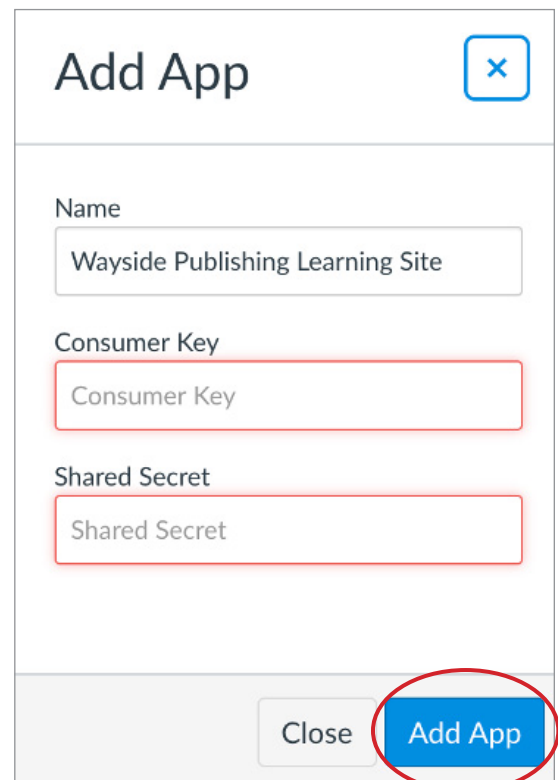

8. Next, select **View App Configurations** to ensure the Wayside Publishing® Learning Site® LTI Edu App has been assigned to the correct users.

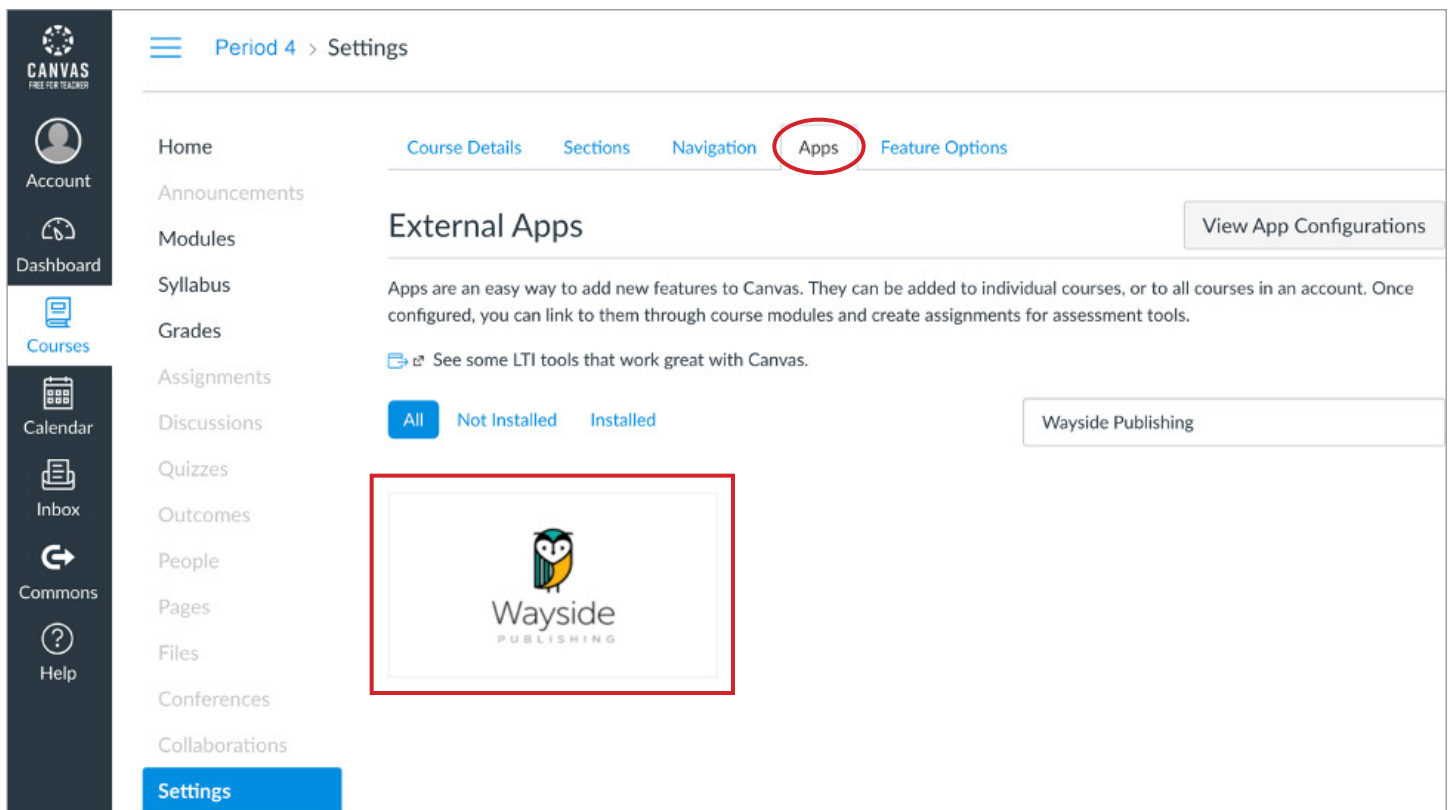

Installing the LTI Edu App: Course-Level Instructions

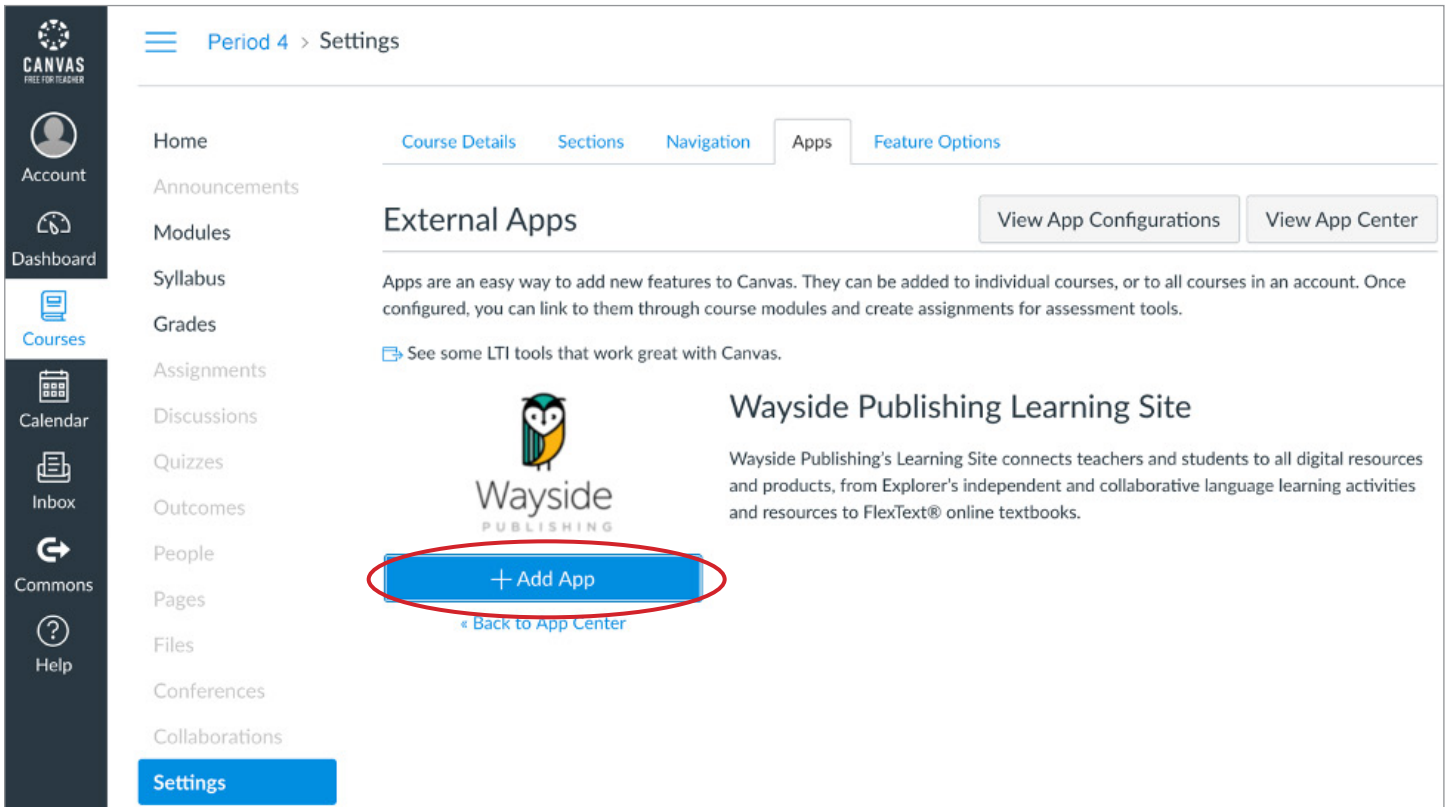
If your Canvas administrator has not installed the Wayside Publishing[®] LTI Edu App, please follow the directions below. You will need to install the Wayside Publishing[®] LTI Edu App into each instructional course with which you will be using the Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®].

1. Contact the Wayside Publishing[®] Integrations Team at rostering@waysidepublishing.com to receive the Consumer Key and Shared Secret for your district.
2. In your Canvas instructional account, navigate to your course Settings page.
3. Select **Apps**.
4. Enter “Wayside Publishing” into the search field and select the **Wayside Publishing[®] external app**.

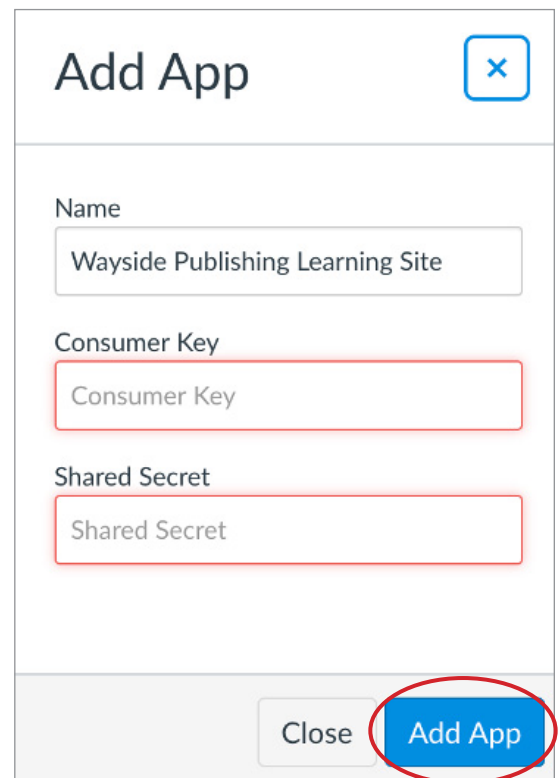

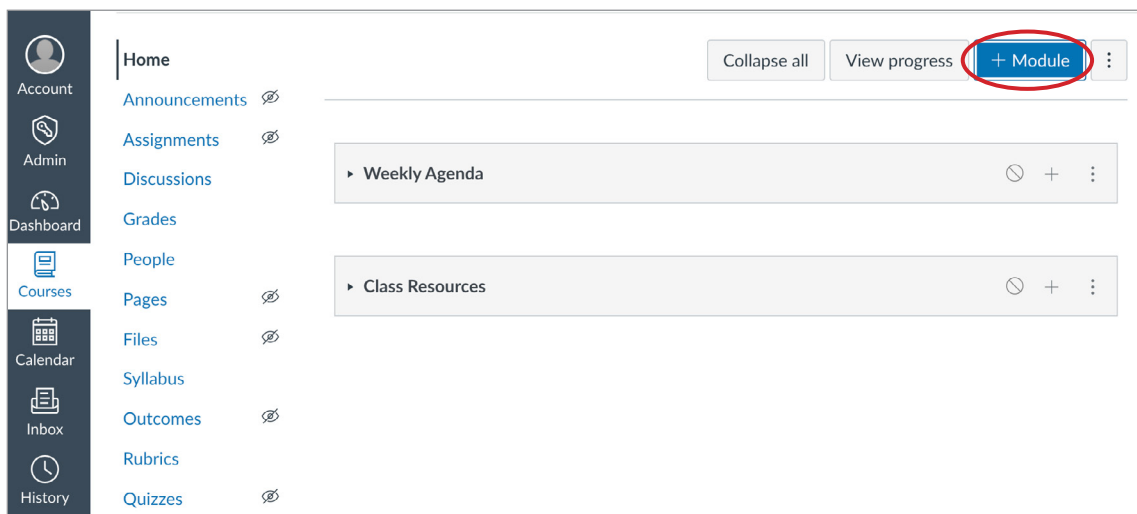
Adding the LTI Edu App to a Module Link

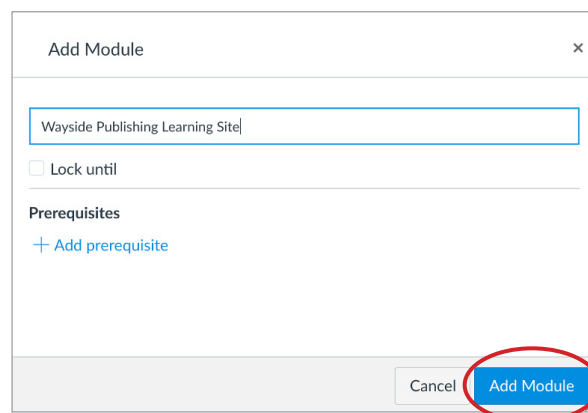



TIP: The Wayside Publishing® LTI Edu App can be added to a new or existing module. It can also be added multiple modules.

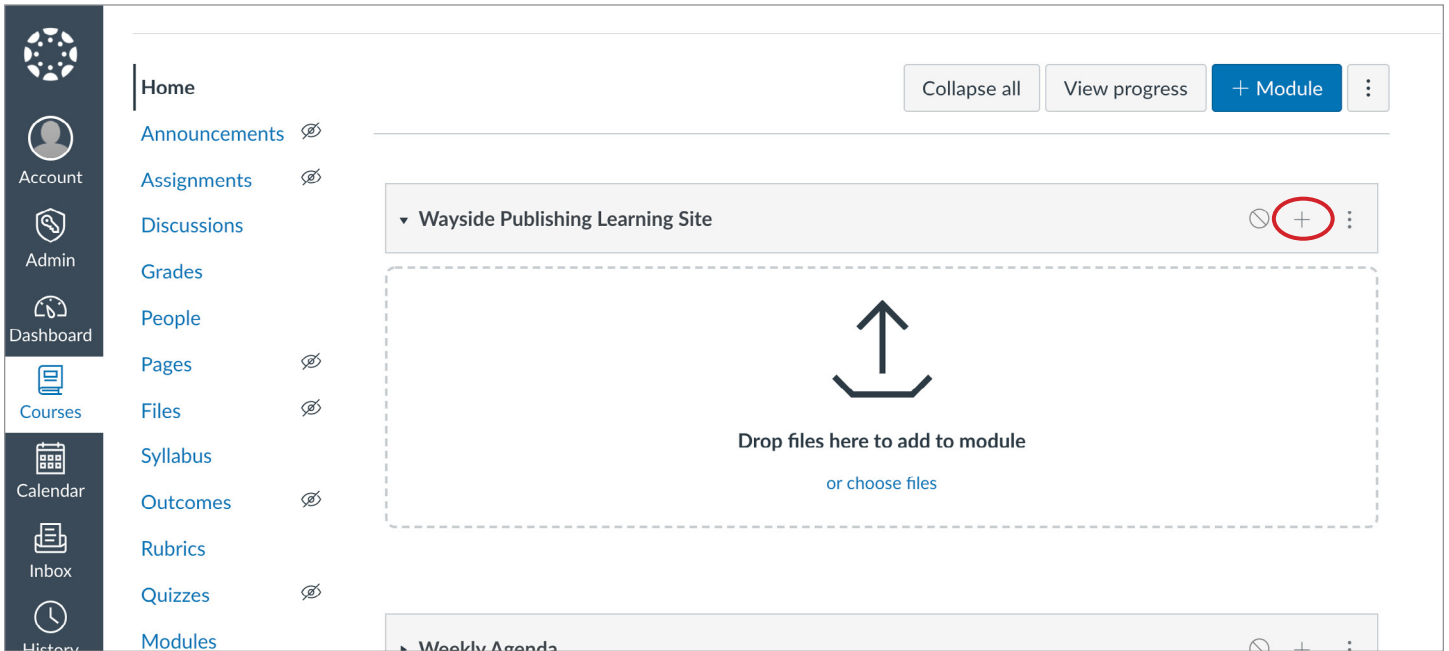
1. To add a new module, navigate to the Modules page of your instructional course and select the **+ Module** button.



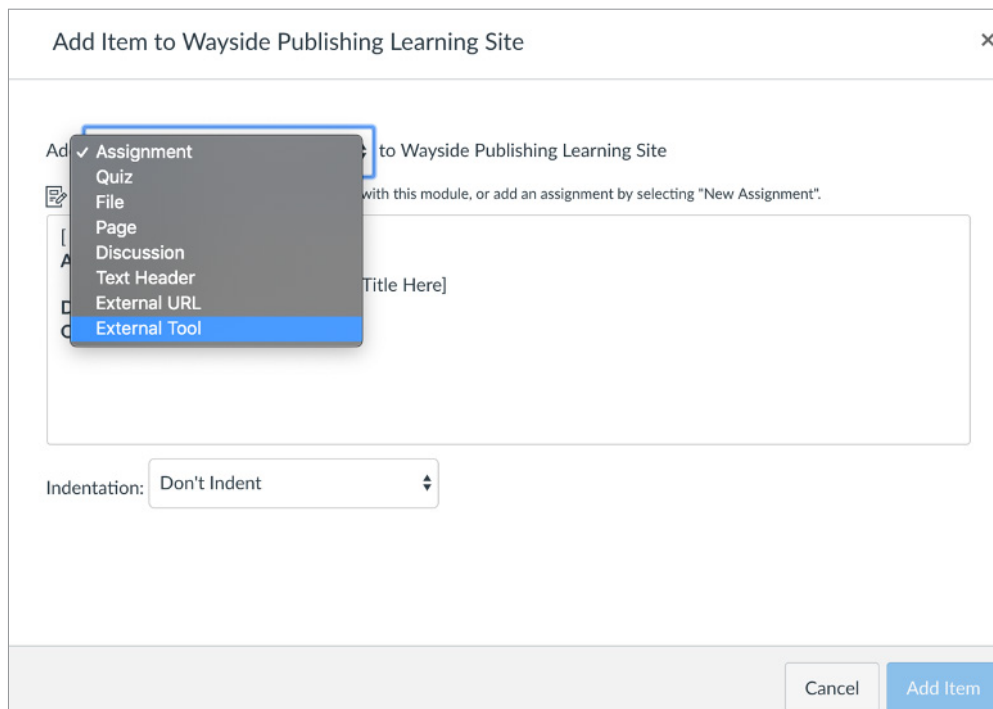
2. In the pop-up window, type a name for your module. We recommend using “Wayside Publishing Learning Site”.
3. When ready, select the **Add Module** button.



4. To add the Wayside Publishing[®] LTI Edu App to a module as an external tool, select the  button on right side of the module.



5. Select **External Tool** from the Add Item drop-down menu.




6. Select the **Wayside Publishing Learning Site** external tool from the list.
7. Next, select how you would like to launch, or view, the Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®].
 - a. Select the **Load in a new tab** check box if you would like to have the Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®] launch in a new tab.
 - b. Leave the **Load in a new tab** check box unchecked if you would like to have the Wayside Publishing[®] Learning Site[®] embedded as an iframe within the module.
8. When ready, select **Add Item** to add the Wayside Publishing[®] LTI Edu App to the module.

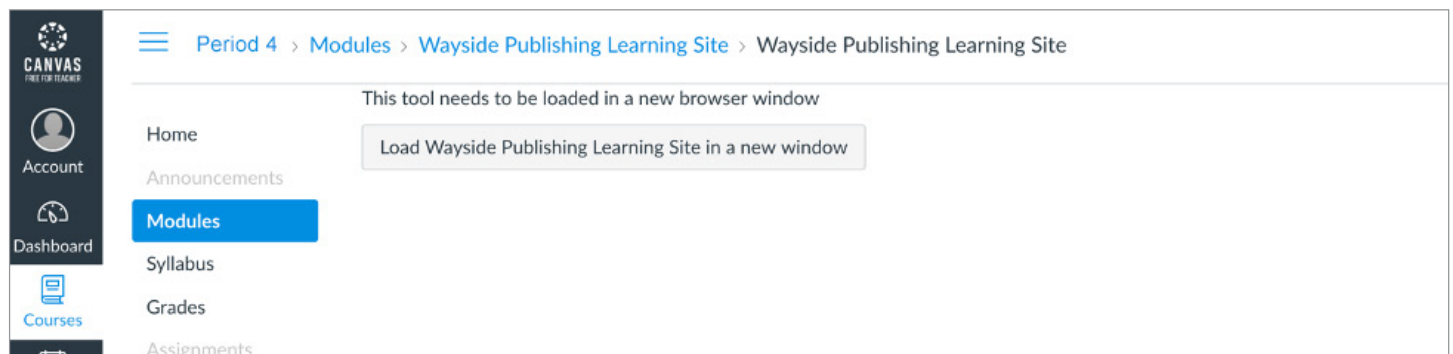
Accessing Learning Site®

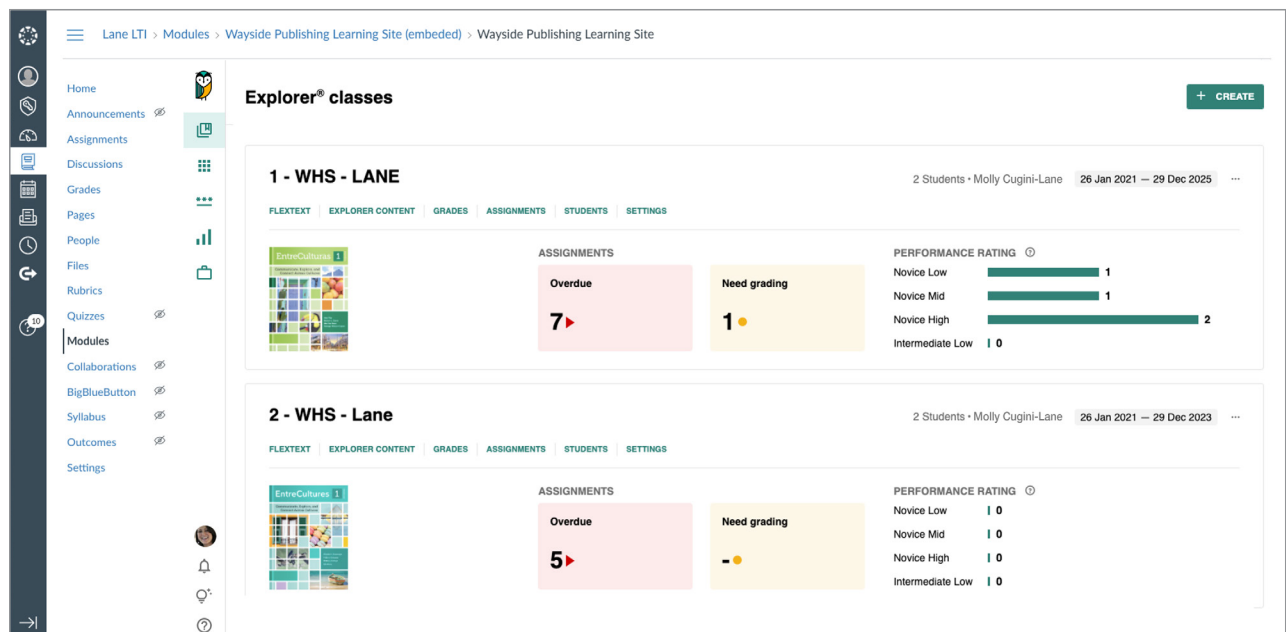
TIP: Be sure the module with the Wayside Publishing® Learning Site® external tool link is published for students.

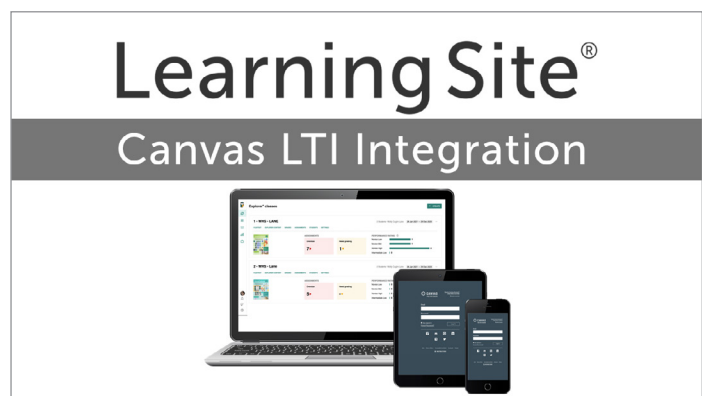
