FlexText[®] is the digital version of your text. The built-in tools and compass icon allow teachers and students to directly interact and engage with content.

FlexText[®] – Teacher Overview

Teachers have access to both the Student and Teacher Editions of a textbook. Comprehensionbased readers do not have Teacher Editions.



FlexText[®] Navigation Tools

Navigate

Use the Table of Contents to quickly navigate to a section of FlexText[®]. Teachers and students can also scroll through the FlexText[®] pages.

Q Search

Search by keyword or phrase in the target language or English.

Jump to Page

Enter a page number to jump to that page in FlexText[®].





FlexText[®] Built-in Tools

Notes & Highlights

Use the Notes tool to add highlights and notes to any page. Teachers can keep separate notes and highlights in the Teacher and Student Editions.

Go to a note or highlight location in FlexText[®] by selecting it from the Notes menu.

Captured notes or highlights can be deleted or edited at any time.

Notes and highlights can be exported into an editable document.

Compass Icon

The compass icon allows teachers and students to interact with related content and embedded media without leaving FlexText[®].

Hover over the **compass icon** to view the number of items related to a section of FlexText[®].

Select the **compass icon** to view the Related Items menu and access related content.

Select the **hyperlinked title** to open the activity or resource in the Explorer[®] Content tab, or select **pop-out** \square to open it in a new tab.

Select the **Actions** button to view the quick actions menu based on content type. To learn more about each quick action, please see the Compass Icon Actions Menu section of this guide.

Compass Icon Actions Menu


Activities and resources, depending on the type, have specific actions available for teachers and students. These actions can be taken by using the Actions drop-down menu within the FlexText[®] compass icon. Use the chart below to learn more about each action.

ACTION	DESCRIPTION					
Preview	 Selecting Preview allows teachers to view task activities without attempting and view answers to auto-graded task activities. 					
	Only teachers can preview a task activity.					
Attempt	Teachers and students can attempt a task activity by selecting Attempt.					
Grades No Grades Available	 Teachers can access student task submissions by selecting Grades. The Grades link or button will enable after at least one student has submitted a task activity (assigned or unassigned). If there are no student submissions, the button will be disabled and indicate no grades are available. 					
	 Students can access their task submission(s) and review their grade and feedback by selecting Grades. The Grades link or button will enable once a student has submitted their task activity. 					
Assign	 Individual activities and resources can be assigned by selecting Assign. To assign more than one activity or resource at a time, please see the Assignments Guide. Only teachers can assign activities or resources. 					
Share	 Selecting Share allows teachers using Google Classroom to create a Google Classroom activity post for an individual activity or resource. Only teachers can share activities to Google Classroom. 					
Settings	 Teachers can adjust properties for an <u>individual task activity</u> by selecting Settings. To adjust properties that affect an entire Explorer[®] class, please see the Settings Guide. Only teachers can adjust properties for individual tasks or an Explorer[®] class. 					
Print Task	 Teachers can print a PDF of the task activity by selecting Print Task. Only teachers can print tasks. 					
View	Teachers and students can view flashcards by selecting View.					



Learning Site® Media Player

Audio and videos can be accessed from the compass icon without having to navigate away from FlexText[®].



Selecting the media resource's hyperlinked title will open it on the Explorer[®] Content page.


Select **Show preview** to open the media player within the compass icon Related Items menu. Select **Hide preview** to close the media player.

- Play and pause media
- Adjust the volume
- Use the picture-in-picture feature to move the video around the screen while also being able to scroll to other areas on the current FlexText[®] page
- C Open the video to fit full screen on your device
- From the three-dot menu, you can toggle captioning/subtitles on and off and adjust audio playback speed



FlexText[®] – Student Overview

The Learning Site[®] FlexText[®] experience for teachers and students is similar with some differences in features, view, and actions.



- · Students have access to the Student Edition only.
- Navigation and FlexText[®] tools are the same for teachers and students.
- Related content is accessible through the compass icon. The compass icon is disabled for students if teachers select to make content hidden.
- The Actions menu has student-specific actions based on content type. Please see the Compass Icon Actions Menu chart in this guide for student-specific actions.
