The Settings page allows you to customize each Explorer® Class. You can adjust default properties for media settings, task attempts, and grading properties using the Custom settings tab. Use the Show/Hide content tab to adjust what content is visible (or hidden) for students.

Please note that the Settings page is only visible to teachers and does not show in a student account.

Custom Settings

The Custom settings tab allows teachers to adjust media, task attempt, and grading properties.

Media

You can enable or disable student access to transcripts and subtitles/closed captions by adjusting the toggles in the Media section. Select **Customize** to adjust settings for specific students.

Attempts

Change the default maximum number of attempts for all tasks in an entire Explorer® class. The default number is set to 3.



Please note that changes to the default maximum number of attempts will affect all tasks, including ones already submitted (unless the task has customized settings).

Grading

Set your gradebook preferences by selecting to grade by **Percentages** or **Points**. Grading by percentages is the default.

Enable or disable grading for punctuation, accents, and capitalization using each toggle. The default setting is ungraded for these criteria.

Customized Individual Tasks

Individual task activities can have custom settings that differ from the Explorer® class defaults on the Settings page.

Select the **Settings** action link on an individual task activity from the Learning Materials, FlexText®, or Explorer® Content page.

Next, use the toggle in the Edit task settings window to enable the custom settings for that task.
